A Guide to Common Symptoms

The guide below lists some of the more common symptoms children experience, together with possible causes, to help you decide which entries may be most helpful to you in a particular circumstance. Although your child may be experiencing one or more of the symptoms listed here, he/she may or may not have any of the illnesses mentioned. Diseases are listed because they can cause the particular symptoms, and they are listed in alphabetical order—not in order of the likelihood of occurrence. This chart is not meant to substitute for the advice of a qualified healthcare provider; always consult with your physician or other licensed practitioner for a professional diagnosis.

Symptom	Possible Causes
Abdominal pain	Appendicitis, celiac disease, colic, constipation, diarrhea, emotional upset, food allergies, hepatitis, intestinal obstruction, menstrual cramps, motion sickness, nausea, pneumonia, poliomyelitis, urinary tract infection
Anal itching	Parasites, pinworms, rectal fissure/tear, yeast infection
Increased	Diabetes mellitus, overexertion, thyroid disorders
appetite Bedwetting	Common cold, diabetes mellitus, emotional upset, food allergies, small bladder capacity, urinary tract infection
Painful bowel movement	Colitis, constipation, rectal fissure/tear
Rapid breathing Cold sweat	Asthma, bronchiolitis, croup, pneumonia, shock Shock
Cough	Allergies, asthma, bronchiolitis, bronchitis, common cold, croup, emotional upset, viral or bacterial infection, tuberculosis, whooping cough
Diarrhea	Celiac disease, food poisoning, viral or bacterial infection
Earache	Allergies, common cold, ear infection, rapid air pressure changes, sinusitis
Difficulty eating	Cancer, canker sores, food allergies, goiter, herpes virus (cold sores), mononucleosis, mumps, sore throat from strep or viral infection, teething, tetanus, thrush
Eye inflammation	Allergies, common cold, conjunctivitis, foreign body in the eye, onset of measles, stye
Fatigue, weakness	Anemia, cancer, depression, diabetes mellitus, , hypothyroidism, poor nutrition, bacterial or viral infection
Fever	Immunization reaction, overexertion (especially on hot days), viral or bacterial infection
Head itching	Eczema, lice, psoriasis, seborrhea
Headache	Allergies, cancer (brain tumor), chickenpox, common cold, concussion (head injury), diphtheria, emotional upset, influenza, measles, meningitis, mononucleosis, motion sickness, mumps, poliomyelitis, sinusitis, stress, tension, tuberculosis, visual problems
Irritability, restlessness	Allergies, asthma, colic, diabetes, emotional upset, hyperactivity, immunization reaction, meningitis, motion sickness, teething, viral or bacterial infection
Aching joints	German measles, hepatitis, influenza, juvenile rheumatoid arthritis, rheumatic fever
Swollen lymph nodes	Cancer (lymphoma), dermatitis, herpes virus, lice, viral or bacterial infection
Mouth sores	Canker sores, food allergies, herpes virus, onset of measles, thrush
Runny or stuffy nose	Allergies (airborne or food), bronchitis, common cold, measles, sinusitis
Seizure	Cancer (brain tumor), epilepsy, fever, head injury, immunization reaction
Skin rash,	Acne, allergies (food) or contact, athlete's foot, boils, chickenpox, cradle cap, diaper rash, eczema, German measles,
lesions, or	hepatitis, herpes virus, immunization reaction, impetigo, measles, mononucleosis, poison ivy, prickly heat, rheumatic
bumps Excessive thirst	fever, ringworm, scabies, scarlet fever, sunburn, warts Dehydration, diabetes mellitus
Frequent urination	Diabetes mellitus, excessive caffeine or fluid intake, urinary tract infection, vaginitis
Painful urination	Herpes virus, urinary tract infection
Dark urine	Dehydration, hepatitis, urinary tract infection
Vaginal itching	Allergic reaction, vaginitis (especially yeast infection)
Vomiting	Any viral infection, appendicitis, celiac disease, emotional upset, food allergies, food poisoning, influenza, meningitis, motion sickness, overeating, shock
Weight loss	Cancer, celiac disease, depression, diabetes mellitus, eating disorder, tuberculosis
